Reader A Reading from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah.

The Gospel, The Story of Christmas (based on Luke 2:1-20)

In those days an order went out from the king, Caesar Augustus, that everyone in the world should be taxed. And so each person went to their own city to be counted.

So Joseph went from Nazareth to Judea, to the town of Bethlehem, the City of the ancient Jewish king David, because he was of the house and family of David. He went with Mary, who was to be his wife, who was carrying a child by the power of the Holy Spirit.

And while they were there in Bethlehem, the time came for the baby to be born. And so Mary gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths, and laid him in a manger in a stable, because there was no room for them in the inn.

On a hillside near town, some shepherds were in the fields watching their sheep through the night. Suddenly, an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the sky was filled with God's glory.

The shepherds were all very afraid. But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid! I bring you good news of great joy, good news for all people. Today, in Bethlehem, a baby has been born who is a savior – Christ the Lord! And this will be a sign for you - you will find the baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."

Then suddenly, the sky was filled with angels singing, praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest, and peace to all people on earth!"

The shepherds hurried to Bethlehem and soon found the stable.

There in the manger lay a tiny baby. They told Mary and Joseph what they had seen and heard that night, and Mary and Joseph shared their amazement.

Mary listened very carefully and cherished all these things in her heart. The shepherds went back to their sheep on the hillside, singing God's praises for everything had been as the angel had said.

John 1:1-14

THE REV. COURTNEY A.U. TAN

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through him, and without him not one thing came into being. What has come into being in him was life, and the life was the light of all people. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it.

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him. He himself was not the light, but he came to testify to the light. The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world.

He was in the world, and the world came into being through him; yet the world did not know him. He came to what was his own, and his own people did not accept him. But to all who received him, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God, who were born, not of blood or of the will of the flesh or of the will of man, but of God. And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of the father's only son, full of grace and truth.
