First Reading

Isaiah 6:1-8

¹ In the year of the death of Uzziah, ruler of Judah, I saw Yahweh seated on a high and lofty judgment seat, in a robe whose train filled the Temple. ² Seraphs were stationed above; each of them had six wings: with two they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. ³ They would cry out to one another, "Holy! Holy! Holy is God Omnipotent! All the earth is filled with God's glory!" ⁴ The doorposts and thresholds quaked at the sound of their shouting, and the Temple kept filling with smoke. ⁵ Then I said, "Woe is me, I am doomed! I have unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips! And my eyes have seen the Ruler, God Omnipotent!" ⁶ Then one of the seraphs flew to me, holding an ember which it had taken with tongs from the altar. ⁷ The seraph touched my mouth with the ember. John 3:1-17

Reader The ✠ Holy Gospel of our ✠ Savior Jesus Christ ✠ according to John.

¹ A certain Pharisee named Nicodemus, a member of the Sanhedrin, ² came to Jesus at night. "Rabbi," he said, "we know you're a teacher come from God, for no one can perform the signs and wonders you do, unless by the power of God."

³ Jesus gave Nicodemus this answer: "The truth of the matter is, unless one is born from above, one cannot see God's dominion."

⁴ Nicodemus said, "How can an adult be born a second time? I can't go back into my mother's womb to be born again!"

⁵ Jesus replied: "The truth of the matter is, no one can enter God's realm without being born of water and the Spirit. ⁶ What is born of the flesh is flesh; what is born of the Spirit is Spirit. ⁷ So don't be surprised when I tell you that you must be born from above. ⁸ The wind blows where it will. You hear the sound it makes, but you don't know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit."

Leader Do you turn to Christ as Spiritual Source and Guide?

Sponsors *I do.*

Leader Praise God who made heaven and earth,

Baptismal Covenant (*standing, as able*)

Leader Do you believe and trust in God the Creator, Father and Mother of us all, source of all being and life, the one in whom we exist?

All ***I believe and trust in God the Creator.***

Leader Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died as one of us and rose again?

All ***I believe and trust in God the Son.***

Leader Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

All ***I believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit.***

Leader This is the faith of the Church.

All ***This is our faith. We believe and trust in one God, Creating Presence, Redeeming Son and Holy, Life-giving Spirit.***

Leader Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers?

All ***I will, with God's help.***

Leader Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord?

All ***I will, with God's help.***

Leader Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in Christ?

All ***I will, with God's help.***

Leader Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbor as yourself?

All ***I will, with God's help.***

Leader Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being?

All ***I will, with God's help.***

Signing with the Cross

The Leader makes the sign of the cross on the forehead of each candidate, saying

Leader Faithful and loving God, bless those who care for this child and grant them your gifts of love, wisdom and faith. Pour upon them your healing and reconciling love, and protect their homes from danger. Fill them with the light of your presence and establish them in the joy of your dominion, through Jesus Christ our Savior.

Bringing before you the bread of life and cup of salvation, we proclaim his death and resurrection until he comes in glory.

Continue to look with favor on your people, gather us in your loving arms and bring us with Blessed Mark, Blessed Mary of Magdala, Blessed Mary, Mother of Jesus, and all the saints to feast at your table in heaven.

Through Christ, and with Christ, and in Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory are yours, Almighty God, for ever and ever.
